Structure of College Fees

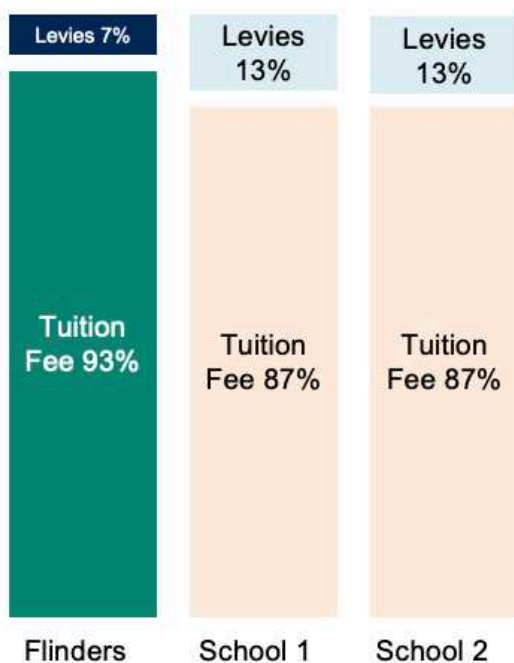
Our College fees consist of the Tuition Fee and a number of specific levies such as the Technology Levy, Textbook and Resources Levy, Excursion and Activities Levy, and Mobile Device Co-contribution. The cost of co-curricular activities, optional tours and excursions, individual music tuition or instrument hire and some sporting activities are additional and charged throughout the year.

At Flinders, the Tuition Fee covers most student education costs including tuition, camps, library resources, internet facilities, diaries, locker combination locks and ID cards.

The College has a transparent levy structure that reflects the true costs of these items and charges. It is important to note that other schools may include items covered in the Flinders Tuition Fees in their levies. For example, local competitor schools may include up to 25% of total fees as levies, compared to Flinders' College Fees where levies account for approximately 10% of the total school fee.

We encourage families to consider the total school fee when comparing schools.
