The Science of Learning Conference in partnership with <u>**Studentnet**</u> is pleased to provide two conference bursaries to support attendance at our inaugural Science of Learning Conference.

The bursary initiative recognises the equity of access issues faced by those teachers who, for reasons of geographic location, have few opportunities to attend conferences and/or find the costs of travel are a mitigating factor to attendance.

Each successful applicant will be granted a bursary to the value of \$750.00 to support conference registration and travel/accommodation costs.

Eligibility Criteria Educators interested in applying must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Currently work as a teacher within a Queensland or Northern Territory remote or regional school context
- Can provide evidence of their own, or their school's, engagement with the approaches, practices and principles of the Science of Learning

Preference may be given to applicants who:

- Have a leadership or coaching responsibility relating to the Conference theme 'Science of Learning'
- Have a proven track record of leading teaching and learning innovation in their school

Application & Selection Process

Only people who meet all eligibility criteria should apply. Please review the criteria above, and be sure that you are eligible before applying.

Applications should be submitted via the online form by: 11.59pm Friday, 3 January 2025.

Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified of the results by COB Friday, 10 January. It is not possible to provide feedback on applications, and no correspondence about the list of awardees will be possible.

Successful applications will be required to participate in Science of Learning Conference media and promotions.
